

DOMESTIC VIOLENCE: 1 in 3 women and 1 in 4 men have been the victim of severe physical violence by an intimate partner
41% of homicides in Virginia are related to intimate partner violence
75% of abused women attempt suicide

HUMAN TRAFFICKING: Every 30 seconds someone is the victim of human trafficking in the U.S.
Last year the trafficking industry generated \$32 billion...
More than Nike, Google and Starbucks combined
Slavery was abolished 150 years ago, yet there are more people in slavery today than any other time in our history

SEXUAL ASSAULT: Every 98 seconds someone in the US is sexually assaulted
1 in 6 American women has been the victim of rape or attempted rape in her lifetime
64% of trans people will experience sexual assault in their lifetimes

HOMELESSNESS: Domestic violence is the leading cause of homelessness among women 90% of homeless women are victims of severe physical violence of sexual abuse

CHILDREN: Children of violent homes are:
6 times more likely to commit suicide
24 times more likely to be sexually assaulted
60 times more likely to be involved in delinquent behavior

Programs and Services

Samaritan House provides comprehensive support services and housing to women, men and children in our region. Whether we work with victims of domestic violence, sexual assault, human trafficking or homeless families, our purpose is the same. We provide safety and a way out for people who are in danger and need support.

Victim Advocates help clients with safety planning, securing protective orders, and navigating the legal system. The Victim Advocacy Program served **over 600 people that were experiencing violence and requested help in the past 12 months.**

Children's Programs support the needs of children exposed to violence. Based on the screening tools, we provide therapeutic services such as art and play therapy, family counseling and academic support. **Over 500 children came through one of our programs last year and received support.**

Emergency Housing through one of our 12 emergency properties provides safety to our clients fleeing violent situations. **Over 200 households are assisted in emergency housing each year, 65% of those housed are children.**

Housing NOW assists families with securing their own permanent housing as quickly as possible. Housing Locator's help clients begin rebuilding their lives and regaining their independence. **Approximately 200 households are permanently housed each year.**

Case Management is an integral part of all programs and services provided by Samaritan House. Case managers assist clients with transportation, nutrition, counseling, medical care, dental care, workforce development and employment. **Case managers assist more than 400 clients annually.**

Community Education and Outreach is available to anyone interested in learning about domestic violence, sexual assault or human trafficking as well as prevention education.



How Can You Help

Annual or Special Event Partnership (ongoing)
